Château de Tauzia is our first wine to receive HEV (High Environmental Value) certification. This is currently the only French certification available for agricultural businesses whose practices are particularly environmentally-friendly.

What does environmental certification for agricultural business entail?

It is a voluntary certification for wine growers.

It is overseen by independent third-party organisations approved by the French Ministry of Agriculture.

It is based on four themes, which are dear to our hearts, and which we have been actively addressing for over 12 years:

Environmental certification has 3 successive levels. At the third level, known as “High Environmental Value”, the business is **accountable for its results.**



Only Level 3 certified businesses, such as Château de Tauzia (available in supermarkets) can mention HEV on their products.

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
